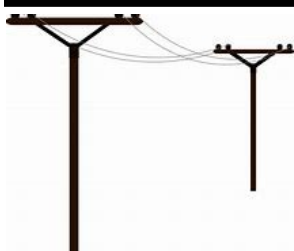

NOMINATING COMMITTEE & ANNUAL MEETING

The 2023 Nominating Committee members were picked by the board of trustees at the November and December meetings, and the names were then posted. The Nominating Committee will meet on January 10 at the MYEC office.

The purpose of the Nominating Committee is to select candidates for the board of trustees. The Cooperative members will have an opportunity to vote for candidates at the next annual meeting. The Committee consists of two members from District #1 (Town of Hysham), District #3 (Sanders and Sarpy Creek) and District #6 (Hammond Valley/North of Forsyth) along with one member from each of the other 4 districts. The committee will nominate candidates for the three seats that are up for election. The present trustees holding seats in these districts are Arlo Jensen (District #1), Richard Pinkerton (District #3) and Tim Fulton (District #6).
