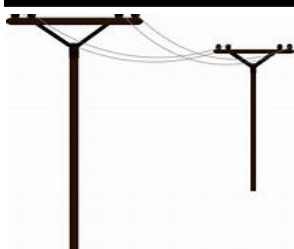

The purpose of the Nominating Committee is to select candidates for the board of trustees. The Cooperative members will have an opportunity to vote for candidates at the next annual meeting in March. The Committee consists of two members from District #1 (Town of Hysam), District #3 (Sanders and Sarpy Creek) and District #6 (Hammond Valley/North of Forsyth) along with one member from each of the other 4 districts. The committee will nominate candidates for the three seats that are up for election. The present trustees holding seats in these districts are Reese Stahl (District #1), Richard Pinkerton (District #3) and Tim Fulton (District #6).
