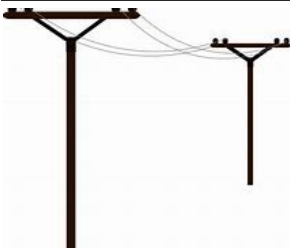

UPDATE ON AMR METERS

MYEC received another shipment of AMR meters after the first of the year, and the linemen have been busy getting them installed. The meters have mainly been placed in areas where there is adequate cell service. There have been a few meters placed in other areas to do testing to see if the readings will be transmitted to the office or not. Areas such as Tullock Creek, Sarpy Creek, and Rosebud Creek may have some troubles transmitting readings; however, MYEC is working with the meter company and Lower Yellowstone Rural Electric Coop to figure out what technology is needed to get those readings 'pinged' from one tower to another. Because of the AMR meters being installed, MYEC billing has become much more efficient without having to estimate as many meter readings.
